	<p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Already ongoing or implemented regulatory process(es)</p> <p>ECHA conducted a compliance check prior to the proposed substance evaluation for propyl acetate and issued compliance check decisions in October 2016 and August 2019. The decisions included requests for a sub-chronic toxicity study (90-day, OECD TG 413), a pre-natal developmental toxicity study (OECD TG 414) in a first species, a pre-natal developmental toxicity study (OECD TG 414) in a second species and an extended one-generation reproductive toxicity study (OECD TG 443) with propyl acetate.</p> <p>The IE CA considers that the information provided in response to the compliance check decisions is sufficient to address the initial concern for reproductive toxicity identified in the CoRAP justification document. In addition, the IE CA considers that based on the OECD TG 413 study, further assessment of the DNELs and RCRs is not warranted at this time. Therefore, it is concluded that substance evaluation is no longer required.</p> <p>The substance is considered low priority for further regulatory action at this time.</p>
