	☑ Already ongoing or implemented regulatory risk management process(es)
	A compliance check prior to substance evaluation was performed with the substance. As a result, comprehensive new information on reproductive toxicity (prenatal developmental toxicity study (OECD TG 414) and EOGRTS with DIT cohort (OECD TG 443)) was generated. Thus, we consider that the results of the new studies clarify the initial concern for reproductive toxicity and therefore, substance evaluation is no longer needed for this substance. As part of the regulatory strategy for the alkylated pyrazoles, BE agreed to submit a proposal for harmonisation of the classification as toxic to reproduction by December 2021.
