

### AGREEMENT OF THE MEMBER STATE COMMITTEE

### **ON CYCLODODECANE**

According to Articles 57 and 59 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006<sup>1</sup>

Adopted on 8 October 2008

France presented a proposal in accordance with Article 59(3) and Annex XV of the REACH Regulation (26 June 2008, submission number AK002049-56) on identification of cyclododecane as a substance of very high concern because of its PBT properties.

The Annex XV dossier was circulated to Member States on the 30 of June 2008 and the Annex XV report was made available to Interested Parties on the ECHA website on the same date according to Articles 59(3) and 59(4).

Comments were received from both Member States and Interested Parties on the proposal.

The dossier was referred to the Member State Committee on 15 September and was discussed in the meeting of the Member State Committee on 7 - 8 October 2008.

# Agreement of the Member State Committee in accordance with Article 59(8):

It is considered that it is currently not possible to justify the identification of cyclododecane as a substance of very high concern under Article 57 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH).

## UNDERLYING ARGUMENTATION FOR IDENTIFICATION OF SUBSTANCE OF VERY HIGH CONCERN

The B and vB criteria under Annex XIII are met. However, only screening data are available for T and P.

Therefore, there is currently not sufficient information available to conclude that cyclododecane can be identified:

- as a PBT/vPvB substance in accordance with Article 57(d) or (e) or
- as a substance of equivalent level of concern as specified in Article 57 (f).
