The priority for evaluating the substance has been reconsidered based on:

## The initial hazard ground of concern has been verified and considered of low priority

## The initial exposure/risk ground of concern has been verified and considered of low priority

Initial concern:

- Suspected PBT/vPvB properties. Due to use in ordinary consumer products (sunscreen lotion) the substance was estimated to have wide dispersive use.
Verfication:
- Consumer use of Undecenyl crylene as such seems unlikely as the substance is formulated to a polymer outside of the EU before preparation of the sunscreen ingredient in the EU. Therefore the estimated wide dispersive use of Undecenyl crylene would concern only a small amount of unreacted monomer in sunscreen lotions, if any.
- Due to low tonnage of the substance (1-10 t/y) and use only in polymerized form, substance evaluation of Undecenyl crylene is for the present not considered a priority by the FI CA.
